### For a boat

#### Yellow Tail Moscato \$9

If a ripe apricot could effervesce into wine, it would be this new white from mighty Aussie winemaker Yellow Tail. It's hard not to chug-a-lug this faintly fizzyfruit wine, but that's OK — it's a mere 7 percent alcohol.

Tuck a bottle away after a visit to 54 Wine & Spirits (400 W. 55th St.) and head to one of three Hudson River locations that have free kayaking on weekends ([downtownboathouse.org](http://downtownboathouse.org)). Though, drinking and paddling might not be such a good idea. . . Pack gazpacho soup from Zabar's (2245 Broadway; \$7.49 a quart) and kick back dockside.
