I have finally tried all three and they are all wonderful, but all very different from each other too. I adore the tiny bottles too, they are very high on the cuteness scale. I tried the moscato first because I wasn't convinced that I would like it, being that it is sweeter than the others. I was pleasantly surprised to find that it is quite drinkable, not cloyingly sweet like some sweet wines can be. To me it had a very subtle honey taste but it was smooth and would be perfect for those that like sweeter wine.

I tried the bubbles next and it was satisfyingly dry and smooth, a hint of grapeyness with wonderful little bubbles that danced on my tongue. I could easily drink this as my regular sparkling drop.
